Gates will be open by 0800hrs as one of the Co-ordinators will be there by 0755 - please be there!

0755- Coordinators arrive – Helpers arrive - unload ponies etc

0815 - Start Set up

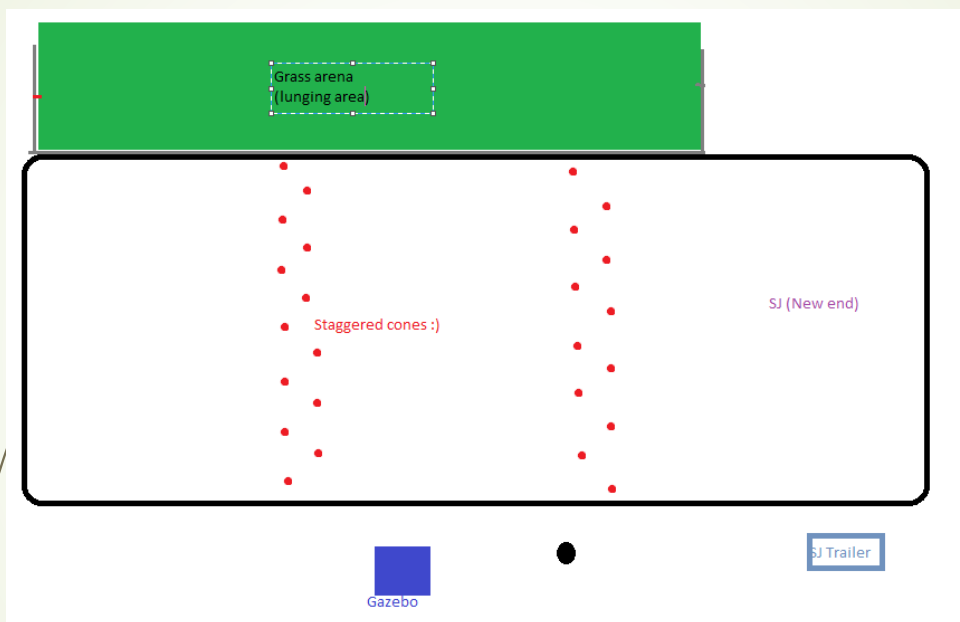
Sam & Rhiannan and all helpers to shed

Sam & Rhiannan – Unlock shed, turn on hot water, get jumps trailer out & unlock toilets.

- **Adele Craker, Steve Dundon, Liz Kilpatrick**– Trailer duties (chairs/mounting block/table/if raining/hot get both tents)

- **Hayley Baker & Yvonne Dinnage** - Kitchen duties (Get Tea/Coffee/Hot water/spoons/cold drinks etc ready and put in car... you may have to come back for hot water as it takes some time to heat up)

- **Sam, Rhiannan and helpers** Divide arena into 3rds using cones. The new/deep end to be slightly larger to accommodate for SJ and cones to be staggered to allow a 2mtr laneway between each 3rd for safety. See below diagram ☺



0830-

SJ set up – All hands on deck please. Including other members who are floating around.. If you see someone “floating around or gas bagging” please do not hesitate to politely ask if they could lend a hand, especially if they will be doing SJ/poles at some stage during the day. See above diagram. Jumps trailer to be parked down new end of arena.

After SJ set up is complete: **Sam, Simone, Yvonne, Adele, Steve, Hayley & Liz** – Complete set up of gazebo/s, tables and chairs etc

11:30 - Co-Ordinator/s or a helper: Get instructors lunch orders – head down street to collect lunch Jobs Throughout Day:

SJ assist - If you could please pick a SJ session each and assist SJ Instructor by picking up poles etc and when not doing that just the general bits and pieces.

Everyone - when you are not riding can you please assist with poo pick up, looking after instructors – tea/ coffee/ snacks and also keep an eye out if the SJ assistant needs a hand in the SJ session.

Things to remember: Checking flasks for hot water. Are the instructors happy? Can I see any poo and have a lovely day ☺

Pack Up

SJ pack up – All hands on deck please.

Pick up poo / collect cones / start harrowing ASAP (Could somebody without a float please harrow?)

Pretty much set up but in reverse.

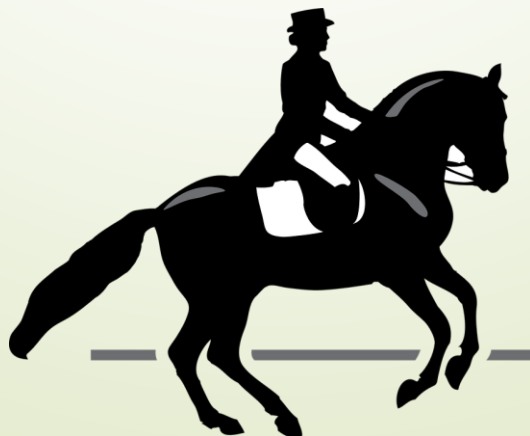

Whittlesea Adult Riders 2018 Show Jumping Club Championships

Saturday 1st September 2018



Set up on the day!
All riders must arrive to help set up.

Jackpot Sashes to 8th Place, Perpetual Trophy for overall Club Champion

Advise: Your name, Horse's Name and SJ Level by Monday 27th August.

Club Championships based on a Jackpot scoring system.

Each rider competes in the two classes at their assessed level.

The type of class allows everyone to be placed according to their faults regardless of their level.

Time will be used to split equal placings.

Time allowed varies for each level- so fastest time across all levels will be used to award placings.

Points are awarded for placings in this overall listing as per Jackpot scoring system.

Jackpot points for the overall placings for each class are totalled to give the Club Champion.

Equal Jackpot placings will be split according to placing in Class 2

SJ JUDGE—T.B.A.

Course Builder – Adrian Wright

Class one: ONE ROUND STAKES

Competitors jump one round. Competitors on equal number of faults are split according to time taken to complete the round. Riders with the fastest time (no. of seconds under time allowed for their level) places higher. There is no jump off.

Class two: TABLE AM7

A competition judged under Table A, not against the clock with a time allowed in the first round. A competitor with a clear round must remain in the arena for a jump-off against the clock. The judge rings the bell to indicate that he/she is ready for the competitor to start the jump-off of the competition. A competitor who fails to pass through the start of the jump-off within 30 seconds of the bell incurs elimination. In the case of equality of faults in the jump-off, time will decide the placing's. In the case of equality of faults and time, equal placing's will be awarded. If the number of competitors who reach the jump-off is insufficient to fill all placing's, the additional placing's will be decided on faults from the first round, with equal placing's being awarded as necessary.

WHITTLESEA ADULT RIDERS INC. UNIFORM

Following is the club uniform guidelines which is incorporated into our club bylaws. These uniform items are to be used when competing at official HRC AV competitions representing our club.

Green polo shirt with gold logo over breast, with or without bottle green jumper with gold logo on breast.

A light coloured shirt (white, cream, ivory, champagne, lemon, pale gold or pale green shirt) with predominantly bottle green tie, **or** light coloured shirt (as stated above) with rat catcher or stock, with bottle green vest with gold logo on breast **or** V necked woolen jumper with gold logo on breast and

White, beige, banana, ivory, butter or light gold jodhpurs or breeches; and

Long black /brown boots **or** black/brown leather boots and leather gaiters and ASA approved helmet; and

Bottle green saddle blanket with gold logo, with or without gold trim, white saddle blanket with green logo or sheepskin numnah/half numnah
