A quick reminder to all members to please spread/kick your horse's manure on the grass areas and do not leave in clumps where your horse was tied to your float. Also any manure MUST be picked up out of the yards and spread over the grass area, not thrown over the fence line around trees.

We have been lucky enough to have some guest show jumping instructors over the past couple of months. Russell Johnstone in June and Murray Lamperd in July. These instructors were kind enough to visit our club and impart their invaluable knowledge. We will try to have more guest instructors from time to time and if any member has a request, please send an email to one of our committee members and we can discuss at upcoming meetings.

### Housekeeping Information!

Please remember not to put manure around the trees or over the fence line behind the yards etc. We have a wheel barrow and wire rake for picking up manure from the sand arena at the rallies/events etc... These items must be returned to the shed after pack up. Please do not leave clumps of manure on grass areas, try to spread.

- If you are participating in show jumping or poles please help set up and/or remain until finish to help pack up.

### **RALLY HELPER INSTRUCTIONS**

Gates will be open by 08:00hrs by one of the Co-ordinators 8:00am Coordinators arrive – Helpers arrive - unload ponies etc 8:15am Start<u>Set up</u>

### Co-ordinators and all helpers to shed

Co-ordinators – Unlock shed, turn on hot water, get jumps trailer out & unlock toilets.

- Jess, Megan, Belinda, Rebecca – Trailer duties (chairs/mounting block/table/if raining/hot get both tents)

- Sam, Liz & Liz - Kitchen duties (Get Tea/Coffee/Hot water/spoons/cold drinks etc ready and put in car... you may have to come back for hot water as it takes some time to heat up)

- Divide arena into 3rds using cones. The north end of arena to be slightly larger to accommodate for SJ and cones to be staggered to allow a 2mtr laneway between each 3<sup>rd</sup> for safety.

### <u>08:30-</u>

**SJ set up** – All hands on deck please. Including other members who are floating around.. If you see someone "floating around or gas bagging" please do not hesitate to politely ask if they could lend a hand, especially if they will be doing SJ/poles at some stage during the day. See above diagram.

Jumps trailer to be parked down new end of arena.

After SJ set up is complete: **Co-ordinators & rally helpers** – Complete set up of gazebo/s, tables and chairs etc. **11:30** - Co-Ordinator/s or a helper: Get instructors lunch orders – head down street to collect lunch

Jobs Throughout Day:

SJ assist - If you could please pick a SJ session each and assist SJ Instructor by picking up poles etc and when not doing that just the general bits and pieces.

**Everyone** - when you are not riding can you please assist with poo pick up, looking after instructors – tea/ coffee/ snacks and also keep an eye out if the SJ assistant needs a hand in the SJ session.

Things to remember: Checking flasks for hot water. Are the instructors happy? Can I see any poo and have a lovely day © Pack Up

**SJ pack up –** All hands on deck please.

Pick up poo / collect cones

Pretty much set up but in reverse.

NOTE: Harrowing of the sand arena is to be decided by the co-ordinators on the day. If it is too windy, then we MUST NOT harrow the arena.

# LESSON ETIQUETTE

This is just a friendly reminder to all members when having your lessons, whether at rallies or the mid-week rallies and/or Clinics, please try to refrain from talking or interrupting the instructor before your lesson has started or after your lesson has finished.

Sometimes the lessons run overtime due to riders talking one on one with the instructors and then the next rider's lesson maybe cut short due to time constraints.

We suggest that if you need to speak with the instructors, send them a private message later or speak to them at the end of the day when there are no other riders waiting for their lessons.



# WARM UP RULES/ETIQUETTE

• riders should pass left shoulder to left shoulder when on the track

• when not on the outside track, eg on a diagonal line, riders should give way to horses on their left

- the more progressive gait has priority on the track
- halt should not be on the track
- walk should not be on the track and does not have right of way
- trot has priority over walk
- canter has priority over trot
- lateral work has priority over all paces
- when circling, anticipate your return to the track so as to not stop the flow of other riders
- mounting, dismounting and gear adjustment should be done off the track
- consideration should be given to behaviour of other horses in the arena that may upset your horse
- it may be necessary if your horse is upsetting others to leave the area



# Whittlesea Adult Riders Club Highpoint Awards

As in previous years, Highpoint Awards will be a part of the end of year celebrations for our Club at our Christmas function. After much discussion, the Committee is trialing a new format and basis for participation in the Highpoint Awards, to encourage all members to focus on our great Club and the activities scheduled throughout the year.

The Committee agreed that the focus this year will be on members' contributions and active support of the Whittlesea Adult Riders Club itself, with placings at HRCAV events playing a lesser role in the Award process.

### **Guidelines:**

- •Participation is open to all members of Whittlesea Adult Riders Inc.
- •Onus is on the member to keep a record of relevant representation & competition attendance on the attached form.
- •When members compete at HRCAV events (inclusive of all disciplines), points are earned regardless of the member's placings at the event.
- •The Committee will confirm rally attendances, internal events/working bees.
- •Representation points are earned regardless of the member's performances on the day of the event.
- •Where a member competes on more than one horse, points will be tallied for each horse to give the total points for each combination.

### The formula for the awards is based on points allocated to events and activities, particular to the Club, as follows:

PARTICIPATION	
Monthly Rally Attendance (To be confirmed by Committee)	1 point
Competition Representation (HRCAV Events – all disciplines)	1 point
Attendance at Talk & Test / Specialty Club Days (To be confirmed by Committee)	1 point
Top Teams Representation	2 points
Internal Club Competition participation (To be confirmed by Committee)	2 points
Working Bee attendance (when/if scheduled) (To be confirmed by Committee)	5 points
Helper Duty at Top Teams Events only if not competing.	5 points

Following is the club uniform guidelines which is incorporated into our club bylaws. These uniform items are to be used when competing at official HRCAV competitions representing our club.

Green polo shirt with gold logo over breast, with or without bottle green jumper with gold logo on breast. Our polo tops can be purchased for \$30.00 from Chris Williamson via email on <u>murrilee@bigpond.net.au</u>

A light coloured shirt (white, cream, ivory, champagne, lemon, pale gold or pale green shirt) with predominantly bottle green tie, **or** light coloured shirt (as stated above) with rat catcher or stock, with bottle green vest with gold logo on breast **or** V necked woolen jumper with gold logo on breast and

White, beige, banana, ivory, butter or light gold jodhpurs or breeches for all disciplines or Dark coloured jodhpurs may also be worn when representing the club at official HRCAV Navigation rides and the Cross Country phase of HRCAV Horse Trials and

Long black /brown boots **or** black/brown leather boots and leather gaiters and ASA approved helmet; and

Bottle green saddle blanket with gold logo, with or without gold trim, white saddle blanket with or without green logo or sheepskin numnah/half numnah
