So lets look at the positive side of Covid! We had to postpone our July rally from 17th of July to 31st of July due to lockdown. July 17th was a freezing cold wet day but we were so lucky with July 31st as it was the perfect winters day! We had the sun on our backs for the first time in a long time. Horses and riders happy to be out riding having wonderful lessons with our great instructors, Heidi, Tanja and Brya. Thanks to Rachel and her rally helpers for running the day so smoothly. Just a quick note, please check in every time you arrive at rally using our QR code, located on the front entrance gate and on the central table.

Our Club Show-jumping Champs is soon approaching on **Sunday 19th September.** Anyone interested in riding please contact Leanne. We need at least 6 riders to make it viable to run. Please enter as it's a great chance to practice your jumping skills and get competition practice before TTT Showjumping early October.

Our midweek dressage competition on **Wednesday October 20th** is now advertised on Event Secretary! Please support our club by entering if you are able to do so. We have elected to use the same tests (.2 and .4 tests) as TTT dressage as it is only 2.5 weeks after our event. So good practice for those wanting to ride at the TTT dressage event. The organisation is well underway with judges, photographer, ribbons all sorted. A Helpers Roster will be sent out soon so please let us know if you cannot help. I understand that we have changed the date so some people originally down to help in September may not be able to help due to a change in circumstances.

Our Test &Talk day and our Club Dressage Champs are scheduled for the first weekend in October. We have decided to run with the .4 tests for the Test and Talk on the Saturday to give you good practice and to take away constructive feedback for you to work on before competing in our midweek. As in previous years, you ride at your assessed level only for the Test & Talk day.

For our dressage champs, we have opted to use the .1 tests. The reason being is that we want as many people as possible to attend and not feel overwhelmed by having to ride a harder test at the next level above. As with previous years, riders must ride a test at their assessed level and then another test at the level above. The rider with the best percentages added up from both tests is the winner.

So we have lots coming up including our rallies. Let's all keep our fingers and toes crossed that we are not subjected to too many lockdowns in the future so we can get on with enjoying our riding!

#### **RALLY HELPER INSTRUCTIONS**

Gates will be open by 08:00hrs by the Co-ordinator 8:00am - Helpers arrive - unload ponies etc

8:15am - Start Set up - All helpers to shed

Unlock shed, turn on hot water, get jumps trailer out & unlock toilets.

**Trailer duties** (chairs/mounting block/table/if raining/hot get both tents)

**Kitchen duties** (Get Tea/Coffee/Hot water/spoons/cold drinks etc ready and put in car. You may have to come back for hot water as it takes some time to heat up)

**Arena Set up -** Divide arena into 3rds using cones. The north end of arena to be slightly larger to accommodate for SJ and cones to

be staggered to allow a 2mtr laneway between each 3<sup>rd</sup> for safety.

#### 08:30AM

**SJ set up** – All hands on deck please - including other members who are floating around. If you see someone "floating around or gas bagging" please do not hesitate to politely ask if they could lend a hand, especially if they will be doing SJ/poles at some stage during the day. Jumps trailer to be parked down new end of arena.

After SJ set up is complete: **Co-ordinator & rally helpers** – Complete set up of gazebo/s, tables and chairs etc. as required/needed.

**11:30AM** - **Co-Ordinator or a helper**: Get instructors lunch orders and prepare in kitchen ready for 12Noon lunch break.

#### Jobs Throughout Day:

**SJ assist -** If you could please pick a SJ session each and assist SJ Instructor by picking up poles etc and when not doing that just the general bits and pieces.

**Everyone -** when you are not riding can you please assist with poo pick up, looking after instructors - tea/coffee/snacks and also keep an eye out if the SJ assistant needs a hand in the SJ session.

Things to remember: Checking flasks for hot water. Are the instructors happy? Can I see any poo? .... and have a lovely day <sup>(2)</sup>

#### <u>Pack Up</u>

**SJ pack up** – All hands-on deck please. Pick up poo / collect cones - Pretty much set up but in reverse.

NOTE: Harrowing of the sand arena is to be decided by the co-ordinator on the day. If it is too windy, then we MUST NOT harrow the arena.

### WHEN LOCKING THE DOUBLE-GATES AT THE END OF THE DAY, PLEASE ENSURE THAT THE PADLOCKS ARE LOCKED THROUGH EACH OTHER.

Green polo shirt with gold logo over breast, with or without bottle green jumper with gold logo on breast. Our polo tops can be purchased for \$30.00.

A light-coloured shirt (white, cream, ivory, champagne, lemon, pale gold or pale green shirt) with predominantly bottle green tie, **or** light coloured shirt (as stated above) with rat catcher or stock, with bottle green vest with gold logo on breast **or** V necked woolen jumper with gold logo on breast and

White, beige, banana, ivory, butter or light gold jodhpurs or breeches for all disciplines or Dark coloured jodhpurs may also be worn when representing the club at official HRCAV Navigation rides and the Cross Country phase of HRCAV Horse Trials and

Long black /brown boots **or** black/brown leather boots and leather gaiters and ASA approved helmet; and

Bottle green saddle blanket with gold logo, with or without gold trim, white saddle blanket with or without green logo or sheepskin numnah/half numnah.
